



General requirements for admission:

- The applicant must have a first degree from an Egyptian university or a higher institute recognized by the Supreme Council of Universities.
- For non-Egyptian students (expatriates), the rules governing this are applied according to the provisions of the executive regulations of the Universities Organization Law and the decisions of the Supreme Council of Universities.
- The approval of the employer to study if the student is working or writing a declaration that he does not work in any government agency or private sector.
- A postgraduate student may not enroll in more than one diploma or higher university degree at the same time, except with the approval of the Postgraduate Studies and Research Council based on the proposal of the College Council and after taking the opinion of the relevant department councils in accordance with the provisions of Article 94 of the Universities Organization Law.

In order for the student to obtain the Plant Clinic Diploma, it is required to:

- 1- A Student should have a bachelor's degree in agricultural sciences or basic sciences in a related specialty (determined by the program's board) or an equivalent from one of the universities or institutes recognized by the Supreme Council of Universities to study in the professional diploma program for the botanical clinic if it fulfills the admission requirements.
- 2- That the student fulfills the requirements for acceptance or comparison in the scientific program and obtains the approval of the Board of Directors of the relevant program and the College Council.

- 3- The Student must complete the administratively required documents and forms and upload them electronically to the graduate studies website electronically.
